



Information Security Training services (01/STIKK/2019)

1. Introduction

The field of Information and Communication Technologies is extensively becoming a driving force for establishing a prosperous economy. As of late, knowledge relevant to ICT is the most sought after in local and international markets. This type of knowledge has become essential for any individual to engage in any kind of professional work. In the near future, it is projected that ICT skills will be mandatory in order to get a job, be able to financially profit, engage in research & development activities, and compete in international markets.

Moreover, the training provider should offer certification service to candidates.
