**KosICT** is a tech festival that held its first edition in 2012 with the aim of bridging the gap between the local and international **ICT** markets by highlighting and bringing the latest technological trends and developments to the Balkans, through local, regional, and international experts who would share their experiences and knowledge with the audience comprised out of software developers, ICT enthusiasts and experts, C-level Executives, Academia Representatives, and Students.

Another very important goal of the KosICT tech festival is to **promote the local ICT sector** on an international scale through visitors from international companies attending KosICT, our partner associations, and renowned speakers that grace the stages of KosICT and act as ambassadors for Kosovo and the local ICT sector by promoting their experience here to their colleagues, business partners, etc.

As a technology festival, KosICT is enriched by a few different elements including two conference format stages highlighting some of the latest topics and trends in the ICT industry, an innovation fair focusing on some of the most prominent start-ups, a company fair, and a brokerage event bringing together local & international businesses and Business Lounge area where many of the company representatives had the chance to meet and create potential linkages for the future, future developer's corner, and last but certainly not least, two esports tournaments highlighting the talents among STIKK member companies (CSR Tournament and professional tournament) with the aim of promoting the gaming community in Kosovo.





### SUMMARY

The **12th edition of the KosICT Technology Festival**, held at the vibrant **Klan Arena** in **Prishtina** on **October 13-14, 2023**, was a resounding success, leaving an indelible mark on the world of technology and innovation.

With a diverse and engaging program, the festival boasted a total of 12 captivating sessions on the Main Stage, further enriched by 9 Dev Stage sessions and an inspiring glimpse into the future with the "Future Developers" presentation.

The event was more than just discussions and presentations, offering thrilling entertainment through **2 e-sports tournaments** that showcased the gaming prowess of the participants.

A significant highlight of the festival was the presence of numerous companies and startups that brought their innovative ideas to the forefront. The **Trailblazers Fair featured 18 participating companies**, while the **Innovation Fair introduced 14 dynamic startups**, underscoring the spirit of entrepreneurship that drives the tech community.









The festival also fostered a spirit of collaboration with its **Business** Lounge in operation for 2 days, facilitating essential **B2B** meetings, totaling an impressive 150 over the course of the Brokerage Event.

This dynamic gathering extended its influence beyond the convention halls with a **special workshop on AI designed for children**, nurturing the next generation of tech enthusiasts.

In terms of numbers, the festival attracted around 3,000 eager participants, who had the privilege of engaging with 30 distinguished speakers, including 13 local, 4 from the diaspora, and 13 foreign experts from 10 different countries.

These vibrant discussions and exchanges were made possible through the support of **20 sponsors** and **6 partners**, who shared the festival's vision.

The 12th KosICT Technology Festival was an extraordinary success, embodying the spirit of technology, collaboration, and the exciting possibilities that lie ahead.

### **Main Stage**

The event commenced with a set of inspiring Opening Remarks delivered by a lineup of distinguished speakers. Mr. Ermal Sadiku, Chairman of STIKK Board, set the stage by emphasizing the pivotal role of technology in fostering innovation, economic growth, and sustainability. H.E. As the morning unfolded, attendees were treated to a variety of captivating sessions. Fatos Ismali, Senior Data & AI Solutions Architect at Microsoft, delved into the world of Generative AI in the Real World, elucidating the practical applications of large language models like GPT-4. His talk shed light on how these models are revolutionizing industries, from automated content creation to scientific research, providing a roadmap for leveraging generative AI in various professional fields.



Following this enlightening session, Petru Jucovschi, Managing Director of the Front-office Line of Business Applications and Integrations at Quipu GmbH, took the stage to discuss the Challenges and Opportunities in Banking Services. Gabriel Tataru, Managing Director of IDS Consulting, presented on "Mastering Data Management and Unlocking the Power of Data Warehousing." ### **Developers Stage**

As the second day of the 12th edition of the Kosovo International Computer Science and Telecommunications (KosICT) Festival dawned, the excitement continued to build. The day commenced with an inspiring keynote presentation by Arta Statovci, an expert in AI, Strategy, and Transformation. Her keynote showcased how AI could be the catalyst for Kosovo's digital transformation. She explained that AI had the power to empower Kosovo to establish a digital identity, streamline complex tech processes, reduce costs, and enhance profitability significantly. Arta's presentation was a rallying call to join the mission of building a digital Kosovo, powered by AI technology and the nation's dynamic spirit. Her keynote offered practical solutions and inspired attendees to shape Kosovo's digital future.



Next, the audience delved into the complex world of Internet Protocol Security (IPsec) in the Radio Access Network with Ante Simovic, a Tech Lead at Ericsson Nikola Tesla. He shared invaluable insights on the role of IPsec in ensuring the security of IP transport communication within the Radio Access Network. The significance of this layer 3 security protocol in encrypting, maintaining integrity, and authenticating communication was unveiled. Ante's expertise shed light on the vital role that security protocols play in securing communication within the telecommunications industry.

Betim Drenica, the CEO of Quantix LLC, took the stage to explore the intersection of AI and speech recognition. His presentation, "AI in Speech Recognition / Shqip.ai usecase," unveiled the innovative applications of AI in speech recognition, particularly focusing on Shqip.ai.





Betim's extensive experience as a software architect and startup advocate allowed him to offer unique insights into this evolving field. He shared not only the triumphs but also the challenges of entrepreneurship, encouraging the audience to transform their ideas into reality. Betim's keynote provided inspiration and practical knowledge to navigate the dynamic world of AI and speech recognition.

Edona Haziraj, a Master's student of Media and Human-Centered Computing at Vienna University of Technology, captured the audience's attention with her presentation on "Human Centered Computing: Incorporating HCC Principles in Product Management." She defined and explored the concept of Human-Centered Computing (HCC) and its role in modern product management. Edona emphasized the importance of bridging user needs and technology to develop interactive systems that prioritize accessibility, assistance, and intuitiveness. Lum Ramabaja, the Co-founder and CEO of Open Cybernetics, took center stage to address the democratization of AI. With a background in artificial intelligence, decentralized systems, and bioinformatics, Lum shared insights into the emerging field of Decentralized AI. His mission to make AI accessible to all by developing open-source algorithms that reduce costs was evident. Lum introduced the audience to the challenges in the field and the innovative solutions being developed at Open Cybernetics.

Fabian Berisha, the Lead DevOps Engineer at Appstellar, delivered a captivating keynote on managing a Multi-Tenant Kubernetes Cluster on AWS EKS. His expertise in DevOps and Kubernetes was evident as he shared strategies to navigate the complexities of cloud and container orchestration. Fabian's presentation offered a clear path from chaos to control, empowering aspiring DevOps engineers.

The day continued with an insightful panel discussion on "Opportunities in enabling the digital transformation journey for manufacturing companies."





Moderated by Shpend Ahmeti, a Senior Consultant at Deloitte, the panel featured Dior Halili, ICT Sector Lead at USAID Kosovo Compete Activity, and Partin Imeri, the CEO of Incodeks. At the 12th edition of the KosICT Technology Festival, the Brokerage Event proved to be a dynamic hub for seasoned entrepreneurs, startup enthusiasts, and business professionals eager to propel their endeavors to new heights. Serving as a pivotal bridge between like-minded individuals and companies, the Brokerage Event provided an environment fostering collaboration, innovation, and growth. As a further step in enhancing this collaboration, eight ICT companies participating in KosICT introduced their digital solutions to the Wood and Food Processing sectors.



In total, the B2B area at KosICT hosted a remarkable 150 B2B meetings, bringing together 40 companies to explore possibilities, initiate partnerships, and lay the groundwork for future collaborations.
